





# Model D-120 Mainstation





## **Switch Operation**

- 1. CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCHES (1-12) control talk/listen communication for numbered channels. Press to talk; release to listen.
- 2. INDICATOR LIGHTS on each channel indicate:

  RED. . .talk, GREEN. . .listen, YELLOW. . .channel on "hold", FLASHING YELLOW. . .incoming call waiting.
- 3. HOLD SWITCH places selected channel in "hold" (Left switch 1-6, Right switch 7-12).
- 4. Either ALL CALL SWITCH controls conversation with all channels simultaneously.
- 5. STANDBY INDICATOR LIGHT indicates unit is in STANDBY.
- Either STANDBY SWITCH silences incoming audio to eliminate undesired noise pickup when unit is not in use. Touching any CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH releases STANDBY.

## **Operating Instructions**

- 1. Touch any CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH to talk. Red INDICATOR will light.
- Release switch to LISTEN. Green INDICATOR will light.
- 3. Adjust VOLUME CONTROL for incoming audio level.
- 4. Touch either ALL CALL SWITCH to talk to all channels simultaneously. All Red INDICATORS will light.
- Release ALL CALL SWITCH to listen to all channels simultaneously. Green INDICATORS will light.
- Touch any CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH or standby to cancel ALL CALL/LISTEN.
- Touch HOLD SWITCH (Left switch 1-6, Right switch 7-12) to place selected channel in HOLD while you answer another channel. Yellow INDICATOR will light. Re-establish contact by touching CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH for channel on hold.
- 8. Touch either STANDBY SWITCH to silence all channels. Unit STANDBY INDICATORS will light.

#### **Call Alert**

The Yellow call alert INDICATOR above the CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH flashes and a tone sounds to alert operator of an incoming call. Touch the appropriate CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH to cancel the alert.





## **Switch/Control Operation**

- 1. CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCHES (1-12) control talk/listen communication for numbered channels. Press to talk; release to listen
- RED. . . talk, GREEN . . . listen, YELLOW . . . channel on "hold", FLASHING YELLOW . . . incoming call waiting.
- 3. HOLD SWITCH places selected channel in "hold" (Left switch 1-6, Right switch 7-12).
- Either ALL CALL SWITCH controls conversation with all channels simultaneously.
   STANDBY INDICATOR LIGHT indicates unit is in STANDBY.
- 6. Either STANDBY SWITCH silences incoming audio to eliminate undesired noise pickup when unit is not in use. Touching any CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH releases STANDBY.
- 7. Voice Operated Switching (VOX) MICROPHONE.

2. INDICATOR LIGHTS on each channel indicate:

8. VOLUME CONTROL for adjusting volume of incoming audio.

## Operating Instructions

### 1. Talk/Listen Switching

#### **VOX Mode (Automatic)**

Momentarily touch the desired CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH. Speak directly into the microphone from approximately a 2-inch (5 cm) distance. The unit automatically switches to the TALK mode on the selected channel. When there is a pause in the voice flow of the operator, the unit automatically switches to the LISTEN mode on the selected channel. The unit automatically switches between TALK and LISTEN modes on the selected channel as the operator speaks. Red and green INDICATORS identify the TALK and LISTEN modes.

#### Manual Mode

Touch any CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH to talk. Red INDICATOR will light on selected channel to indicate TALK mode. Press CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH to continue talking. Release CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH to listen. The green INDICATOR light indicates the LISTEN mode.

#### 2. All Call Mode

Touch and hold either ALL CALL SWITCH to talk to all channels simultaneously. All Red CHANNEL SELECTOR INDICATORS will light. Touch any CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH or STANDBY to cancel ALL CALL.

#### 3. Placing a Channel On Hold

To place a channel ON HOLD while answering another channel, touch left HOLD SWITCH for channels 1-6 or right HOLD SWITCH for channels 7-12. Yellow INDICATOR will light. Touch CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH for channel on hold to re-establish communication.

#### 4. Placing Unit in Standby

Touch either STANDBY SWITCH to silence all channels. Both STANDBY INDICATORS will light.

### 5. Call Alert

The yellow call alert INDICATOR above the CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH flashes and a tone sounds to signal an incoming call. Touch the appropriate CHANNEL SELECTOR SWITCH to answer the call and to cancel the alert tone.
